SUMMARY

SEC updated the Court regard the status of the shortfalls. Global Generation and Progresso Ventures shall file their motions to determine whether they are shareholders or creditors and the extent of their alleged shortfalls (acquisitions/rebates) by 6/29/18. Oppositions due 7/6/18. Replies due 7/10/18. Motion hearing set for Monday 7/16/18 at 1:30 p.m. SEC shall file a motion to establish the fact and extent of any shortfall other than that attributable to Global Generation and Progresso on 6/29/18, any response by any interested party shall be filed by 7/6/18. Once these motions are resolved, SEC, receiver and investor groups shall meet and confer to arrive at a proposed distribution plan (including any possible hybrid proposal, and, if not, to propose a schedule to hear such dispute.

Any outstanding issues listed on the 2/8/2018 minute order (Docket 309) shall be deferred until after the 7/16/18 hearing.

The Court already authorized fees for the receiver up to \$45,000. The Court approved SEC's suggestion to allow another \$5,000 fees for the receiver to complete the process.
