- 2. The Receiver is authorized make an interim distribution to each of the Class 3 Claimants listed in Exhibit 1 to her declaration, in the amount of 80% of the allowed amount of each claim.
- 3. Any Class 3 Claimant wishing to receive a distribution by wire transfer must, within 14 days after the date of this Order, provide the Receiver with valid wire instructions.

 Otherwise, the Receiver shall make distribution by check to each claimant at the claimant's last known address.
- 4. The Receiver may pay any administrative or wire fees or may incur any other reasonable administrative expense necessary to make such distribution.
