1           The *Motion for Order to Make an Interim Distribution to Class 3 Claimants* filed by Kathy  
2 Bazoian Phelps, the successor receiver (the “Receiver”), has been submitted to the above-  
3 referenced Court. The Receiver has represented that she has met and conferred with counsel for the  
4 Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC”), the Investor Advisory Committee, and Progresso  
5 Ventures LLC, and none of them oppose the Motion.

6           The Court having reviewed and considered the Motion, and the Declaration of the Receiver,  
7 pursuant to Local Civil Rule 7-11,

8           GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

9           1.       The Motion is granted in its entirety.

10           2.       The Receiver is authorized make an interim distribution to each of the Class 3  
11 Claimants listed in Exhibit 1 to her declaration, in the amount of 80% of the allowed amount of  
12 each claim.

13           3.       Any Class 3 Claimant wishing to receive a distribution by wire transfer must,  
14 within 14 days after the date of this Order, provide the Receiver with valid wire instructions.  
15 Otherwise, the Receiver shall make distribution by check to each claimant at the claimant’s last  
16 known address.

17           4.       The Receiver may pay any administrative or wire fees or may incur any other  
18 reasonable administrative expense necessary to make such distribution.
